Dear Parents, Carers and Friends

I hope you all enjoyed the sunshine over the Bank Holiday weekend. We were definitely due some nice weather after the Easter Break!

As you will know, we have a weekly theme for our Collective Worship and last week the theme was humility. We shared stories, talked about and reflected on the concept of being humble, about being confident in who you are and doing the right thing because it is the right thing to do. Usually, we share our thoughts through our weekly Worship Warrior challenges, but last week, this challenge was a secret one – to help someone out without telling anyone that you had done it. The challenge extended to being at home as well as at school, so please let me know if you noticed anything!

Earlier this week, some of our pupils noticed a bird's nest tucked in next to Mr Jordan's shed. Soon after, a small selection of notices appeared by the door alerting others to the presence of four tiny chicks and asking for everyone to stay quiet so that they were not disturbed. The children who made the signs saw the chicks and decided by themselves to make them. They made their signs and pinned them up, they didn't show off or shout about it – they just did it because it was the right thing to do. I know you will agree that this is a real-life reflection of their understanding of the theme and of our school value of love.
